- 4. Directly after the sound, give your dog a treat or start a fun game with a toy.

Exercise 17: Teach the treat magnet

• Remain neutral while clicking

- 1. Hold a couple of tasty treats in your hand. This is your magnet.
- 2. Present the "magnet" to your dog's nose (as if you were giving him the treat, but here you hold on to the treat).
- 3. When you dog's nose touches your hand, slip him a treat.
- 4. Keep your hand still.

• Feel your dog's nose

- 5. Your dog touches his nose to your hand again.
- 6. Continue slipping him treats while his nose touches your hand.
- 7. To end the treat magnet, abruptly remove your "magnetic" hand.
